John Kilty Esquire appeared in the Council room and qualified before Henry Ridgely Esquire one of the Aldermen of the City of Annapolis by taking the several Oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and Laws of this State, and making and subscribing a Declaration of his Belief in the Christian Religion [*sic*], and Certificate thereof filed.
