thousand seven hundred and ninety: We do therefore in Pursuance of the powers vested in Us by the Constitution of the United States and by the aforesaid Acts of Assembly, authorise and command you to hold an Election for a person to represent this State in the said House of Representatives, in your said County of on Monday the seventh day of January next at the usual place of holding Elections and that after giving ten Days Notice at the least excluding the Day of Notice and the Day of Election you then and there attend, conduct regulate and make return of the said election agreeably to the directions of the aforesaid Act of Assembly passed November session one thousand seven hundred and ninety.

Given in Council at the City of Annapolis under the Seal of the State of Maryland this twenty first Day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety two.
