That the said Treasurer pay to Jubb Fowler Eighteen pounds, fifteen shillings for one quarter's Salary as Messenger to the Council and keeper of the Stadt House due this Day,

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Denny Fifty pounds for one quarter's Salary as Auditor, due this Day,

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson jun'r Sixty two pounds, ten shillings for one quarter's Salary as Clerk of the Council due this Day,

That the said Treasurer pay to Christopher Richmond Agent, Two hundred and thirty nine pounds nineteen shillings and eleven pence for one quarter's salary each of himself, John Wright and John Hannah due this Day, and for contingent Expences per Account passed by the Auditor.
