Resolved that the said William Marbury shall keep a fair account of all Certificates he so exchanges and present a full Statement thereof before the 5th of March next.

Resolved that the said William Marbury proceed to Baltimore and other parts of the State where he may think it probable such subscribeable [*sic*] Certificates may be procured. And the Board will make him reasonable compensation for his trouble.
