The following proposition was made and assented to :

That a person be appointed on the part of this State to attend the sales of property, which may be taken in execution, issued at the instance of the State for the two shilling and six penny fund tax, and to purchase the same for the use of [p. 154] the State, if a Sale cannot be otherwise made So as to Secure a reasonable price for the property so taken, and to sell and dispose of to the best advantage, all property so purchased for the use of the State in Virtue of An Act entitled “An Act to empower the Governor and Council to compound with the discoverers of british property, and for other purposes”, passed November Session 1788.
