

C H A P. IX.

An Act to confirm to Mary Hall, of Talbot County, Widow, a Tract of Land called Glade's Addition, in Talbot County. Lib. LL. N° 4. fol. 392. PR. Passed 10th May 1718.

C H A P. X.

An Act to limit the Continuance of Actions in several Courts within this Province, and ascertaining the Manner of taking the Evidence of Seafaring Men, and for granting Appeals from the Chancery Court to the Governor and Council. Lib. LL. N° 4. fol. 394. REP. by 1721, ch. 14. Ditto.

A Supplementary Act 1720, ch. 20; which was Repealed by the same Act.

C H A P. XII.

An Act to enable Benjamin Howard to sell certain Lands in Ann-Arundel County; and for the entailing other Lands belonging to the said Benjamin, in Baltimore County. Lib. LL. N° 4. fol. 397. PR. Ditto.

C H A P. XIII.

An Act for the removing the Court-house from Charles-Town in Prince-George's County; and for the building a Court-house for the said County at the Town of Marlborough in the said County; and for making Sale of the old Court-house and Prison. Lib. LL. N° 4. fol. 399. Ditto.

C H A P. XIV.

An Act for confirming the Last Will and Testament of Elizabeth Devegh, late of Baltimore County, deceased; and for vesting in John Devegh, his Heirs and Assigns for ever, an Estate in Fee-simple, in all and singular the Lands, Tenements and Hereditaments, whereof the said Elizabeth Devegh died seized as aforesaid.
