V. Provided always, That no Offender shall receive above Thirty-nine The Whipping, &c. li-Lashes, or be kept in the Stocks above Three Hours, upon any one Conmited. viction.

VI. And be it Enaîted, That every Magistrate, or other Officer, appoint-Penalty on ed to put this Act in Execution, and being guilty themselves of Cursing, Magistrates, ಆ c. guilty of Swearing, or Drunkenness, or omitting to punish others according to Law, Swearing or Drunkenness, shall for every such Offence or Omission, and Conviction thereof, in Manner or omitting aforesaid, before any other Magistrate or Officer aforementioned, forseit Ten to punish Shillings Current Money; to be levied and applied as aforesaid. others.

VII. And he it Enasted, That if any Offender shall revile or abuse any Offenders re-Magistrate, or other Officer, putting this Act in Execution, the Offender viling any Magistrate, shall be obliged to give good Security (in the Sum of Five Pounds Current. ජීc. in the Execution of Money) for his good Behaviour for the Space of Three Months, and in Dethis Act, how fault thereof to suffer one Month's Imprisonment, without Bail or Mainprize.

VIII. And be it Enasted, That if any Magistrate, or other Person put-Magistrates, &c. assaulted. ting this Act in Execution, shall be assaulted or beaten by the Offender, or any other, that the Party grieved, if he brings an Action of Assault and Battery, shall and may recover treble Damages and full Costs.

IX. And be it Enaced, That if any Person shall be sued or impleaded for General Issue. any Thing to be done in Execution of this Act, the Defendant may plead the General Issue, and give this Act and the Special Matter in Evidence; and if a Verdict shall be found for the Defendant, or the Plaintiff be Non suit, or discontinue his Action, the Defendant shall have and recover treble Costs.

X. And be it Enacted, That no Person whatsoever, shall Work, or do any Sabbath-Breaking pu- bodily Labour on the Lord's Day, commonly called Sunday, and that no Pernishable by a son, having Children, Servants or Slaves, shall command, or wittingly or Fine of 200 th willingly fuffer any of them to do any Manner of Work or Labour on the Lord's Day, (Works of Necessity and Charity always excepted) nor shall suffer or permit any Children, Servants or Slaves, to profane the Lord's Day, by Gaming, Fishing, Fowling, Hunting, or unlawful Pastimes or Recreations: And that every Person transgressing this Act, and being thereof convict, by the Oath of one sufficient Witness, or Confession of the Party before a fingle Magistrate, shall forseit Two Hundred Pounds of Tobacco to be levied and applied as aforefaid.

XI. And be it likewise Enacted, That no House-keeper shall sell any Penalty on House-keep- strong Liquor on Sunday, (except in Cases of absolute Necessity) or suffer any Drunkenness, Gaming, or unlawful Sports or Recreations, in his or her ers felling Itrong L1-House, on Pain of forfeiting Two Thousand Pounds of Tobacco to his Lordquors on Sunday, &c. ship, one Half to the Use aforesaid, and the other Half to him that will sue for the same; to be recovered by Action of Debt, Bill, Plaint or Information, wherein no Essoin, Protection or Wager of Law shall be allowed.
