At a Session of ASSEMBLY begun and held at the 1728. City of *Annapolis*, in the County of *Ann-Arundel*, for the Province of *Maryland*, on the Third Day of *October*, and ended the 2d Day of *November*, in the 14th Year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable CHARLES, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of *Maryland* and *Avalon*, Lord Baron of *Baltimore*, &c. Annoq; Domini 1728, were Enacted the following Laws, viz.
