C H A P.

A Supplementary ACT to an Act, entitled, * An Act laying an April 1735. Imposition on Negroes, and several sorts of Liquors imported; 1715,cb.36. and also on Irish Servants, to prevent the importing too great a Number of Irish Papists into this Province. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 121.

ORASMUCH as it appears to this General Assembly, to be a Hard-Preamble. ship on the Importers of Servants and Slaves into this Province, to pay Duty for such as shall happen to die, or be exported again before Sale; Be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the No Duty to Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses be paid for Slaves or Serof Assembly, and the Authority of the Jame, That no Person or Persons what-vants Dying, soever, hereafter Importing any Servants or Slaves, shall be chargeable with, or Exported before Sale, or liable to pay, any Duty for any Servant or Slave that shall happen to Die, or be Exported out of this Province, before Sale of the faid Servant or Slave.

II. Provided always, That such Death or Exportation, shall happen if such Death within Three Months after the Importation of fuch Servant or Slave; and happen withthat the faid Person or Persons who shall define the Repost of this A.O. do it is 3 Months, that the said Person or Persons, who shall desire the Benefit of this Act, shall declare on his, her, or their corporal Oaths, to be administrated by the Naval of which, Oath to be Officer, on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty GOD, That such Servant or made.
