C H A P. VII.

An Act relating to the Placing and Building a Prison in Somerset County. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 147. Passed 6th May 1736.

N. B. This Act directs the Goal for Somerset County, to be built at *Princess-Anne-Town.*

C H A P. VIII.

An Act enabling the Commissioners or Trustees for Emitting the Bills of Credit, established by Act of Assembly, to pay to the Representatives of several Counties, the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds each. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 147. Ditto.

C H A P. IX.

An Act ascertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco Hogsheads, and to prevent cutting, cropping and defacing Tobacco taken on board Ships or Vessels upon Freight. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 148. EXP. Ditto.

To be in Force 3 Years, &c. Continued 1740, ch. 10; 1744, ch. 7; and by 1747, ch. 26, till the 1st December 1748, when it expired at the Commencement of the Inspection Law.

C H A P. X.

An Act to cut off the Entail of a Tract of Land, lying in Dorchester County, called Anderton's Point, containing One Hundred and Eight Acres, and to entail in lieu thereof One Hundred and Eleven Acres of Land, lying in the said County, being Part of a Tract called Richardson's Choice. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 150. PR. Ditto.

C H A P. XI.

An Act for the Payment of a Sum of Money to Andrew Ramsay, Henry Maccaul, and William Gordon, of Glasgow, in the Kingdom of Great-Britain, Merchants. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 150. PR. Ditto.

^s Viz. To repay them 50 l. 15 s. Sterling, paid by them for the Duties of 290 Hogsheads of Tobacco, which were lost at Sea.

C H A P. XII.

An Act for the further Assessment of Twenty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, on the Taxable Inhabitants of Durham Parish, in Charles County, to be applied to the finishing of a new Church in the said Parish, already begun to be built. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 151. OBS. Ditto.

C H A P. XIII.

An Act for the further Assessment of so much Money on the Taxable Inhabitants of King and Queen Parish, in St. Mary's and Charles Counties, as will build a new Church in that Part of the Parish which lies in St. Mary's County, for the repairing of Newport Church in the same Parish, and to appoint a Time for the Freeholders to meet in Order to chuse a Place to build the said Church upon. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 151. OBS. Ditto.

C H A P. XIV.

An Act for the building a Court-house and Repository for the Records in Leonard-Town, in St. Mary's County. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 153. OBS. Ditto.

C H A P. XV.

An Act to render the Navigation up Patuxent River above Queen-Anne Town, in Prince George's County, more easy and effectual. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 154. PR. Ditto.

Viz. To enable the Patuxent Iron-Work Company, to clear Roads, &c. on the Sides of the River, for dragging Boats, &c. up or down the River.

C H A P. XVI.

An Act to cut off the Entail of a Tract of Land, containing One Hundred and Thirty Acres, lying in Dorchester County, being Part of a Tract of Land called Goodridge's Choice, and to entail, in lieu thereof, a Tract of Land called The Hope, containing Fifty Acres; also another Tract called The Addition to the Hope, containing One Hundred and Seventeen Acres; both lying in the said County of Dorchester.
