E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with The Act of the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and so far as re-Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That so much lates to St. Mary's, Soof an Act of Assembly, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at merjet, &c. the City of Annapolis, the Third Day of October One Thousand Seven Hun-Counties redred and Twenty-eight, entitled, An AEt to encourage the destroying of Wolves, Crows and Squirrels, as relates to the Killing of Crows and Squirrels, so far as the same relates to the several Counties of St. Mary's, Somerfet, Charles, Anne-Arundel, Cæcil, Calvert, Worcester, Prince-George's, Frederick, Baltimore, and Dorchester, be, and is hereby repealed, abrogated, and made null and void.

II.
