Edward Hammond of Somerset County Planter was Attached to answer unto Stevens White of A plea wherefore by force and arms into that plantation dwelling house and other Outhouses and Three hundred and Fifty Acres of Land part of A Tract of Land calld Newport Pannell Scituate lying and being in Somersett County aforesaid Which John Watts and Priscilla his wife to him the said Stevens White had demised for A certain term of Years then and yet to come and unexpired entred and him from his farme aforesaid he did Eject expulse and Amove and other harms to him he did doe to the great loss and damage of him the said Stevens and against her Majestys Peace etc.

And Whereupon the said Stevens White by Robert Gouldesbrough his Attorney complaineth that whereas the aforesaid John Watts at Somersett County the tenth day of February One Thousand Seaven hundred and Six demised to him the said Stevens While the plantation and Three Hundred and Fifty Acres of Land part of A tract of Land calld Newport Pannell Lying in Somersett County aforesaid To have and to hold the plantation lands and premises with the appurtenances to him the said Stevens White his heires and Assignes from the Tenth day of February aforesaid for and during the full terme of Three Years from thence next ensuing fully to be compleat and ended by Virtue of which demise the same Stevens into the plantation lands and premises with the appurtenances entred and was thereof possessd untill the said Edward Hammond afterwards (that is to say) the Fourteenth day of February in the Yeare aforesaid by force and [212] arms into the plantation Land and premises aforesaid Which the said John Watts and John Watts and Priscilla his wife to him the said Stephens White had demised for A certain term of Years then and yet to come and unexpired Entred and him from his farme aforesaid he did eject expulse and Amove and other harms to him he did do to the great Loss and damage of the said Stevens and against her Majestys peace Whereupon the said Stevens saith that he damage hath sustaind to the Vallue of Two Hundred pounds Sterling and thereupon he brings this Suite.

And the said Edward Hammond by Cornelius White his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injury when etc. and prays leave to Imparle hereunto until next—and he hath it and the same day is given the plantiff alsoe.

At Which said next Court to witt The first day of Aprill Annoque Dmi 1708 comes again the said partys by their Attornys aforesaid and the said Edward Hamond by his said Attorney prays further leave to Imparle here-
