

6^{thly} Also in that the Scire facias Issued against the said Magdalen Administratrix as aforesaid and the matter therein containd are not sufficient in Law And for that the same Scire facias is insufficient incertain and Wants forme.

7^{thly} And also in that Execution upon that Scire facias is Awarded against the said Magdalen Administratrix of the said James the heir of the said John for the debt and costs and Additionall Costs Acrueing upon that Scire fac^s to be Leavyd of the goods etc. of the said James.

And thereupon the said Jacob and Magdalen pray the Writt of the Lady the Queen to warn the said Hugh Hall Adm^r as aforesaid to be before the Hono^{ble} President and Councill Aforesaid to hear the Errors upon the Record and Process aforesaid
