Whereupon the said Grace Mitchell and Daniel Phillips Administrators as aforesaid by Wornell Hunt their Attorney come and pray leave to Imparle hereunto untill next Court and they have it and the same day is given to the said William Bladen her Majestys said Attorney Generall who for her said Majesty in this behalf prosecuteth also; At which said next Court to witt the Seaventh day of October Anno Domini 1712 come again as well the said William Bladen her Maj^{ty} said Attorney Generall who for her said Majesty
