

the ballance due to the def^t and about the Same time the Said Compl^t desir'd the Deponant to bring the defend^{ts} Acc^t ag^t the Compl^t wth him, upon [405] Which the Defendant Sent the papers hereto annext N^o 1: and 2, and the Dep^o being askt by the Comp^l^t whether (at the time the Def^t delivered the afd Papers N^o 1. and 2) he Said there was any other Sume due to him then what was Mentioned in Said Papers Saith No, but that he often heard the Defendant Say that he Expected amends for his the Said Complainants not Complying wth his whole note to M^r Brice for a large Sume, but whether the Defendant told him so at that time or no he Cannot Remember, but has often hear'd the Said Defendant Complain of the Compl^t not Complying wth his payments in Gen^l, and that he Expected Satisfaction for Such Disappointments or words to that Effect And this Deponent being further Ask^t by the Complain^t whether after the bringing the papers N^o 1. and 2, he sent him to Go or do his Endeavour to Get tobacco in order to pay the Def^t, Answereth and Saith That the Compl^t did Send him this Depon^t to Get Some Tob^o for the Defendant and that he Accordingly made the Said Defendant Severall paym^{ts} and particularly 8. hhd^s w^{ch} was recd by Samuel Dorsey and w^{ch} was the last payment, and the Deponant further Saith that the Said Defend^t Said that upon payment of the Said Hhd^s of Tob^o (tob^o being Scarce) he Should not Expect more that year, but that the Said Defendant desir'd this Deponant to Get as much more (that year, but that the Said Def^t) as he Cou'd and that the Compl^t then Desired this Deponant to pay the Def^t all Tob^o that year as he possibly Could, but this Deponant further Saith that he Cou'd Get no more that year in his Walks.

The Deponant being Examined to the 9th Inter Says he knows nothing of it.

To the 10th Saith That he Remembers M^r George Middleton and himself on or about the 24th Dec^r 1714 Carried from the Compl^t to the Defend^t Some Money and that he beleives the Sume to be to be [sic] 80 pounds or thereabouts Currency, and further Deposeth that he beleives a paper now produced N^o. 5 is a Copy of a Letter then Sent by the Compl^t. to the Defend^t [406] By the Said Deponant and M^r George Middleton, and that a paper likewise produced N^o 6 is an answer thereto. And further Saith that he hear'd the Compl^t. Say at the Same time, that the Said money was in full for the paym^t of the Ball^a of Acc^{ts} as he the Said Compl^t made it, and that he this Deponant understood that if the Said defend^t had recd Said Money he was to allow 8^s 4^d per hundred, And further Saith that the Said Defend^t wou'd not Receive the money but Sent it back again to the Complainant by M^r Middleton and himself and therewth Sent the Said Letter N^o 6, And being Ask^t by the Defendant whether he lookt upon the Said Sume of Money to have been what was recd by Said Compl^t for the Defend^t Saith he knows Nothing thereof. And being further Ask^t whether he knows of the Compl^{ts} receiving any money that year Saith he does not. And being further Ask^t by the
