Thomas Lingan, late of Calvert County Gent: als dict, Thomas Lingan was Summonsed to answer unto his Lordship the Honbie the L<sup>d</sup> Propry of a plea that he render unto him five hundred pounds Sterling which to him he Oweth and unjustly detaineth etc: And whereupon Thomas Bordley Esq<sup>r</sup> his L<sup>d</sup>ships Attorney Gen<sup>24</sup> who for his Lordship prosecuteth Saith that whereas the afsa Thomas Lingan the nineth day of May in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and Eeighteen [sic] at Annarundell County by his Certain Writeing Obligatory did Acknowledge himself to be holden and firmly bound unto his said Laship in the afsa five hundred pounds to be paid to his said Laship when afterwards he shou'd be thereunto required Nevertheless the afsa Thomas Lingan altho Offten required the afs<sup>d</sup> five hundred pounds to the said Lord Prop<sup>r</sup>y hath not rendered but the same to him to render hath refused and Still doth refuse to the damage of the said Lord Propry one Thousand Pounds Sterling money as afsa and this the said Thomas Bordley for the said Lord Propry is ready to verifye etc., and he brings here into Court the writeing Obligatory afsa which Testifies the Debt afsd in form afsd whose date is the day and year above said. The Condition of the above Obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Lingan Exr of all and Singular the Goods Chattles and Credits of Edward Boteler late of Calvert County deced do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and Singular of the goods Chattles and Credits
