Charles Absolute Lord and Prop^y of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon L^d Baron of Baltemore etc. To our Trusty and Well beloved Samuel Young Esq^r Greeting because in the Record and process and also in rendring of Judgment in a plea wth was in Our Provincia^l Court before W^m Holland Esq^r late Cheife Justice of our said Provincia^l Court of Maryland and his Associates Justices of the Same Court by our Writt Between Richard Bennett Esq^r late of Queen Anns County And [468] James Frisby and Peregrine Frisby both of Cecill County Gent^{lm} Admin^{rs} of all and Singular the goods Chattles rights and Creditts which were of Thomas Frisby lately of the same County Gent^{lm} deced Otherwise lately called Thomas Frisby of Cecill County Gent. of a Certain Debt of Fifty Six thousand Eight hundred and forty pounds of good Sound Merchantable leaf Tobacco in well Seasond Cask which the said Richard Bennett required from the said James and Peregrine as it is said Manifest Errors has happen'd to the great damage of the said Richard as of his Complaint We have received We being Willing that the Error afs^d if any there has been, should in due manner be Corrected and full and Speedy Justice done to the parties afs^d in that Part Comand you that if Judgm^t be thereof rendred then the record and process afs^d wth all things thereunto relateing to us under your Seales Distinctly and openly you send and this Writ so that We may have the same before our high Court of Appeales to be held at the City of Annapolis on thursday the 26th of May Instant that the Record and process afs^d being inspected we may further do therein for the Correcting that Error what of right and Accord- ing to the Law and Custom of Great Brittain and this our Province Ought to be done Wittness our Trusty and Well beloved W^m Holland Esq^r Chancellor of Maryland and Keeper of the Great Seale thereof this 25th day of May in the 5th year of his Lordships Dom^a etc: Annoque Domi 1720
