MARYLAND ss^t At a Provincial Court held at the City of Annapolis in the County of Annarundell for the Province of Maryland on the 2^d tuesday in April being the tenth day of the same month in the Seventh year of the Dominion of the Right Hon^{ble} Charles Absolute Lord and Proprietor of the Provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of Baltemore etc: Annoque Domi 1722.
