And whereupon all and Singular the premisses by the said Court nowhere (to witt on the Eighteenth day of July in the term af^d) being seen and fully understood and Diligently Examined and Inspected and mature deliberation being thereupon had it appears to his said L^dships Court of Appeales and Errors now here that in the Record and process af^d as also in the rendring the Judgm^t af^d that it is manifestly Erred It is Considered that the Judgment af^d rendred in the provinciall Court against the said Lord the [575] King for the Errors af^d above Assigned be revoaked Annulled and altogether held for none And that the said Lord the King to all things he by the Judgment af^d hath lost be restored
