You shall swear that as Commissioners in the County of Sommersett
 in all Articles in His Highnes Commission to you directed you shall
 doe equal Right to the poor as to the Rich to the best of your
 cunning with a power and after the president & Custom of
 this Province & Acts of Assembly thereof made; And that
 you hold your Sessions or Court as you are directed in your Commission
 or according to Acts of Assembly provided in that behalf; and
 all fines & discommodities that shall happen to be levied
