 pounds of tobacco;

whereupon the said Tho: Spear said that John Harrison due pay
 unto Tho: Spear on his order four hundred eighty
 three pounds of tobacco with the rest of some other
 account

Know All men by these presents that I Thomas
 Spear of Bees in old England doe hereby constitute
 Appointe my loving friend Mr Charles Ballard living
 in the County of Somerset in the Province of Maryland
 to be my true & Lawfull Attorney for me & in my
 name to give full power & receive whatsoever shall
 be found due to me in the Province of Maryland by
 any bills or accounts or any other way & in case of
 non payment by any person or persons I doe further
