This Indenture made the first day of July in the xxvij
 year of the R^{ty} Hon^{ble} Cecilus abp^l Lord and Proprietor
 of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon Lord Baron of
 Baltimore in the year of our Lord God one thousand six
 hundred sixty eight; Between William Granville of
 Lancashire in the County of Middle in the Kingdom of England
 Mariner of the one part; and Randall Revell of the
 province of Maryland gent: of the other part witnesseth
 That whereas the said Lord Baltimore by his Deed of
 grant under his great seal used in the said Province
 of Maryland for granting of Lands there bearing date
 at St. Maries the 12th day of July in the fourth Christian
 year of his R^{ty} Sup^{ty} Dominion over the said Province
 one thousand six hundred sixty five, did for the con
 sideration therein mentioned grant unto the said
 Randall Revell a certain Tract of the County of Somerset
 All that parcel of Land called the Double purchase
 lying on the eastern shore in Manokin river
 called by the natives Araroco; beginning at a point
 bounded westerly by the mouth of the said river on the
 northern
