

Northern part by the maine river and landing brayng now
 named Mindford on the southermost part by the brayng now
 called Grilford running east southerly into the woods to
 the uttermost part of the said brayngs & of the drawne for
 the easterly bound, surveyed and laid out for three
 thousand acres more or less, to have and to hold to & for the use
 them the said Randall Bevell, and Anne Toft, their heirs
 and assigns forever, under six years Covenant Limitation
 & exceptions, as in & by the said deed of grant & reserves
 being therunto and more at large it doth & may appear,
 Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Randall Bevell
 for available consideration ^{to him} had paid by the s^r. William
 Granville before the enjoining delivery hereof whereof &
 wherewith the said Randall Bevell doth acknowledge
 himselfe to be fully & wholly satisfied & paid and of & for
 every part and parcel hereof acquitt & discharged by said
 William Granville his heirs & assigns & administrators
 by these presents, hath given granted bargained & sold
 and doth by these presents give grant alienate bargain
 sell unto him the said William Granville his heirs &
 assigns forever, a part or parcel of the said indenture or
 tract of land, vizt, one thousand acres bounded as followeth
 beginning at the mouth of the lower forke called Mindford
 & so running northerly up the maine river to the upper
 most forke called the trading brayng & so running
 to the uttermost extent of the said brayngs to the first
 bound, the said Randall Bevell confirming the said
 one thousand acres of land bounded as aforesaid to him
