 unto us that whereas the said Lord Baltimore by his
 Deed of Grant under the great Seal y^e in the said
 Province of Maryland for granting of said th^e bearing
 date at St: Maries the nine and fiftieth day of August
 in the xxvijth year of the Dominion of the R: Hon: ^{our}
 Paecilius 3^r A: D: 1667 did for the Consideration
 therein mentioned grant unto Thomas Cook by the
 Name of Thomas Cook of Sommersett County in the
 Province of Maryland planter; all that parcel of Land
 called Cookes Hope lying in Sommersett County
 aforesaid at the head of the bark creek of Manokin
 beginning at a marked poplar deviding it from the
 Land of Richard Davis thence running by the Land
 of Richard Davis the breadth of one hundred & fifti
 poles to a marked oak, and from thence running easterly
 the length of three hundred twenty five poles to a
 marked pine and from thence running northerly to
 the Damme side the breadth of one hundred & fifti
 poles to a marked tree standing on the southerly
 side of the Damme side downe the southerly
 side of the Damme with severall angles to the
 first bounds containing three hundred acres
