

All the witnesses produced being sworn; It was desired that m<sup>r</sup> Randall Revell would produce his patent for the Land called the Doble purchase in Court, which was denied but it was said that the Jury should have it when they went out upon the business the Jury had all the depositions which are aforementioned delivered to them as also the copy of the foresaid deed, and as the Jury was going out of the Co<sup>rt</sup> the p<sup>r</sup> delivered his patent to the Jury; And the Jury went upon the Cause depending;

The Jury returns to the Co<sup>rt</sup> againe & their names called over every one answered to his name; then the Co<sup>rt</sup> demanded what they were <sup>all</sup> agreed they said they were all agreed; the Co<sup>rt</sup> demanded who should speak for them they answered our foreman m<sup>r</sup> Richard Whittij; the Court asked what they found for the foreman said for the defendant, and delivered writing to the Co<sup>rt</sup> of there verdict signed by the foreman in the behalfe of them all; which was read in these words

To the worshipfull Commission<sup>r</sup> of Somerset County  
 The Jury find, no trespass; and this we all agree to  
 Richard A Whittij  
 Juror foreman

The Co<sup>rt</sup> orders it be entered in the  
 The Jury delivers to the Clerk all papers delivered to them by the Court but none of m<sup>r</sup> Revells patent; the Co<sup>rt</sup> dismiss the Jury; And orders that the depositions taken this Co<sup>rt</sup> together with those m<sup>r</sup> Revell produced; And the verdict of the Jury with the whole proceedings in this Co<sup>rt</sup> be returned to the Justices of the provinciall Co<sup>rt</sup> according to the order of the said provinciall Co<sup>rt</sup>.
