 person or persons so indebted to me & in my name to compound
 Law & obtain writs, favors, Justice, Judgment, Execution,
 & if he shall see fit from prison or execution to deliver & in
 my name to appear in all Courts & places my person to represent
 sent; & Acquittances or other Lawfull discharge or discharges
 in my name to sign, seal & deliver, and to do all things
 as I my self might do (in the premises) if personally present
 Ratifying for better good & effect all & of full power & force
 whatsoever my said attorney shall Lawfully do or cause to be
 done in the premises, In witness whereof I the abovesaid
 Ambrose Dizon have hereunto set my hand & seal this
 twenty fifth day of October A. D. 1670
