Articles of Agreement made the tenth day of October one
thousand six hundred & seventy betweene David Williamson
the one part & Thomas Kendall the other part witnesses
that the s^d David Williamson have bargained & sold unto
the said Thomas Kendall one parcel of land of the hundred
& fifty acres called by the name of Williamsons destiny
& lying at the mouth of Manning bay on the southe side
of the bay & bounded betweene two creeks & bounding
to the land of Thomas Ball, also by these presents I
here doe engage my selfe to give unto the said Tho: Kendall
full possession by my selfe or attorney with deed & bond at
the next County Court at Summersett which is to be holden
the first Tuesday in November next, And for the
aid consideration in full payment of the said land & the
said Tho: Kendall doe by these presents binde my selfe
perpetuall ^{ad} to pay or cause to be paid to David Williamson
or his certaine attorney seven thousand pounds of tobacco
with paye at severall paym^{ts}, viz; the first payment
at the possession & acknowledgment with deed & bond
according to Law on the second Tuesday in November next
