This Indenture made the tenth day of July in the
year of our Lord one thousand six hundred & seventy
Between Thomas Ball of the County of Somerset
in the Province of Maryland on the one party And
Thomas Breton gent, of the County of Northumberland
on the other partie; Whittnesse; That the said Thomas
Ball for and in consideration of three thousand pounds of
Tobacco & Cash in hand received, with which the
said Thomas doth acknowledge himselfe fully satisfied
& paid hath granted bargained sold infixed alliaunt
& confirmed, And by these presents doth grante barge
for infixed Alliaunt & confirme unto the said Thomas
Breton, Apparell of Land called Jans quarter con
taining one hundred & fifty acres of Land more or
lesse; situate lying & being upon the east side
Chesapeake bay on the southermost side or pointe of the
" tomor river beginning for bridge at the westmost
side of a Creek called Williamson Creek at a mark
