This indenture made the tenth day of July in the year  
of our Lord one thousand six hundred & seventy between  
Thomas Ball of the County of Somerset in the Province  
of Maryland on the one part and Jacob Allerton  
of the County of Westmoreland in Virginia gent: of the other  
part witnesseth that the said Thomas Ball for  
in consideration of three thousand pounds of tobacco  
Casse in hand received with which he the said Thomas  
Ball doth acknowledge himselfe fully satisfied  
paid, hath granted, bargained, sold, infeoffed, aliened  
& confirmed, and by these presents doth grant sell  
bargaine infeoffe alien & confirme unto the said  
Jacob Allerton a parcel of Land called Golden quarter  
containing one hundred & fifty acres more or less  
situate
