

That I have certified whom it may concern that whereas John
 Griffell my servant of an indifferent tall stature black short curled
 hair of dyable complexion about twenty eight years old having
 about that time four years three quarters he served me away from
 the subscribed James Shendon of Torremole river in the County
 of Down in the presence of manifest gent: in May in the year
 of our Lord 1669 in company of Thomas Phillips servant to me
 the said James Shendon to me Edward Hale both of the said
 County of Down men who now as I am informed followingly
 employed of others whose name at present I cannot remember
 And whereas I am credibly informed my said servant resides & is
 employed by Capt: Newton of Barrin of Long Island, N. Y. -
 therefore witness that I the said James Shendon do by these presents
 fully empower John London of the said County to use all lawful
 means & means whatsoever to apprehend & returne to
 me the subscribed my said servant & his kin by ratification & confirm
 or cause to be done in relation hereunto requesting by these
 presents all magistrates & officers of Justice to be aiding &
 assisting to the said John London herein in witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal the 15th day of Novemb: 1670
 Know you further that the above named Edward Hale doth give
 the said James power as aforesaid to John London concerning
 the said James above mentioned whose surname is Griffell
 witness whereof the said Edward Hale doth hereunto set his hand
