next & for so doing this shall be your warrant given under my
hand & seal of this County the 9th day of November in the
3rd year of the Dominion of J^r R^t Hon^{ble} Cecilus to
J^r 1670

Whereas by order of Co^{rt} bearing date the 12th day of October
J^r 1669 there was found due unto James Mill's p^t from
Beniamin Lawrence def^t the summe of one thousand 500
hundred forty three pounds of tobacco & two hundred of four
penny nails the s^d p^t James Mill's complaining that the
said tobacco & nails is still unsatisfied

These are therefore in the name of the R^t Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary
to require you to take the body of Beniamin Lawrence into your
Custody & him keep until he shall give in security to appear
by himself or lawful attorney before the next Justice all
the next County Co^{rt} to be held the second Tuesday in January
next there to shew cause wherefore execution might not be
awarded against him for the said debt afore said due to James
Mill's & then return this writ & for so doing this shall be
your warrant given under my hand & seal of this County the 9th
day of November in the 3rd year of the Dominion of
the R^t Hon^{ble} Cecilus to J^r 1670
