counterveil the worth of the bote) as shall happen to arrive upon the
Amount of the said bote furnishing the said Charles Vincent in
whose possession (before the taking away) the said bote was from
the rigor of the Law otherwise it will arrive unto the damages of
the s^d plaintiff whereupon he complained & justly bringeth his suit
