James Davie late of Somerset County was attached  
to answer unto Randall Revell in ap<sup>l</sup>ca of Debt &

And where upon the said Randall Revell for himselfe saith  
That he the said James Davie did upon the first day of  
April in the year of the Dominion of William  
the 3<sup>d</sup> 1670 by a certain speciall<sup>y</sup> signed with the hand & seals  
with the seals of him the said Davie which is produced by  
the plaintiffe here in Court, Assume upon himselfe & promise  
that he the said Davie would pay or cause to be paid unto  
the said Randall Revell of the said County & Province aforesaid  
his Rent & arrears<sup>es</sup> administrat<sup>o</sup>r or assignee the full &  
true quantity of one thousand six hundred pounds of good  
sound merchantable tobacco in the said County  
consideration by him the said Davie received to be paid to  
the said Randall Revell or his aforesaid order upon demand at or  
before the tenth day of October next ensuing the date of the  
said bill at some convenient place in the said County to  
the performance of which he binds himselfe his Rent & arrears<sup>es</sup>  
did administrat<sup>o</sup>r; but he the said Davie hath regarding  
his promise; but fraudently intending to deceive him the  
said Revell of the aforesaid quantity of one thousand six  
hundred pounds of good sound merchantable tobacco in the  
said County being offered demanded but he the said Davie  
will not pay; The plaintiffe saith he is  
damaged
