



tobacco wth cash (being for anvaluable consideration by me
received to be paid unto the said Randall Revell or his assigns
order upon demand at or before the tenth day of October next
ensuing the date hereof at some convenient place in the said
County at witness my hand & seal the thirtieth day of April

1670
