upon the goods chattels & credits of the said Jonas David &c

The pl<sup>t</sup>. produces the following writing which is read  
Loving friend John Lantier I desire you pay foure hundred  
twenty six pounds of tobacco to the bearer hereof Edward Beaud  
for my use he receiving it for Edward Beauregard my letter  
shall satisfy you for so much the performance of this request  
shall engage you friend Jonas David

Matheue Nelson sworne saith that the said Jonas David did  
acknowledge that he did owe unto Edmund Beauregard the  
summe of foure hundred twenty six pounds of tobacco &  
caused me to write a note to John Lantier for the payment  
of the same; but it was my mistake to write Edward instead  
of Edmund Beauregard

Edward Beaud sworne saith that Jonas David did owe him  
that indebted to Edmund Beauregard foure hundred twenty  
six pounds of tobacco; & gave me order to receive for me  
of John Lantier to pay unto Edmund Beauregard & upon that  
order Nelson with the note with Jonas David put his hand to it

Whereupon the C<sup>t</sup> granted writ of attachment  
upon the goods chattels & credits of Jonas David to  
the value of foure hundred twenty six pounds of tobacco
