 of the County aforesaid now in Commission for the  
 said County of Somerset assigned and authorized by  
 Commission under the great Seal of the Province of  
 Maryland; in the Summe of ten thousand pounds of good  
 Lawfull moneys of the Province in Case to be paid to the said  
 Stephen Horssi or to either of the Commissioners or to either  
 or either of their Heires Executors or Assignes; To the  
 payment well truly & faithfully to be made the said  
 George Betts and James Nicollson doe binde themselves  
 jointly & severally their Executors or their Heires Executors  
 Administrators or Assignes for the whole and in the whole  
 firmly by these presents In Witness whereof we the  
 said George Betts & James Nicollson doe hereunto put  
 our hands and Seales this third day of March in the  
 ninth & thirtieth year of the Dominion of the R: Hon:  
 Cecilius C: did in the year of our Lord God one thousand  
 six hundred and Seventy . . . . .
