 in the said Province necessary & needful to be done in or
 about the premises for the recovery of any thing due to me
 of tobacco or goods whatsoever as aforesaid for me & in my name
 to do & execute & performe as fully largely & amply in
 every respect to all intents constructions & purposes as
 I my self might or could do if I were personally present
 Ratifying allowing & holding firme & stable all & whatsoever
