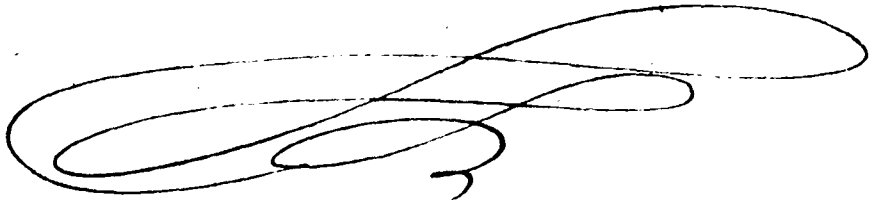

the hand and seal of the def<sup>t</sup> bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of  
July in the year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred  
and seventy for the summe of foure hundred and forty  
pounds of good sound merchantable bright and large draught  
tobacco in C<sup>o</sup> due to be paid at or before the tenth day of  
october 1671 year one thousand six hundred and seventy  
which
