



County in Maryland planter do acknowledge to one and stand
indebted unto John England of the City of Bristol in the
County of the said and best quantity of foure hundred forty
pounds of good sound merchantable bright and large Manors
Tobacco in Cash to be paid from of Thomas Davies plantation
Manors river at or before the tenth day of October next ensuing
the date hereof to the sd. England his Lawfull Attorney R. S.
which execut^o and assign^o; To the which payment well
truly to be made & bind me my heirs execut^o and assign^o
firmly by these presents for matters whereof I have here set
my hand and seal the twentieth of July 1670
