 some convenient place near the sea side upon the  
 River river upon or before the last day of February  
 next coming and shall also pay twelve thousand  
 pounds more of the like good tobacco and Cash at the  
 place aforesaid unto the said Thomas his heirs  
 or assigns upon or before the tenth day of October  
 next coming; Then these present indentures  
 and the power of them shall cease But also they  
 are and at all times shall be hold for goods
