


Schoope which he hath now bought of me shall happen

 provided that the said Cornelius shall doe his best and  
 utmost endeavours to preserve all that may or possibly can  
 be saved or preserved of her or what shall here belong  
 unto her and shall deliver one halfe part thereof unto  
 me the said Thomas at my hand this 24<sup>th</sup> day

of January 1671
