give and grant unto my said attorney full power to bargain

shall thinke fitt and to compromise or agree any Differences  
or Differences that may arise about any said C<sup>t</sup> or other  
thing whatsoever giving and granting unto my said Attorney  
full power and Authority if she shall see kinde fitt to constitute  
& appoint any attorney or attorneys under her for her heirs  
Management of my business Ratifying and Confirming  
by these presents whatsoever my said attorney or any person  
powred by her shall doe in all and any the manner as if  
my selfe were there in presence at witness my hand & seal  
the eight of Aprile 1672.
