Humphrey Davis doe stand indebted unto R<sup>t</sup> Hon<sup>ble</sup> Lord Proprietary  
of summe of ten thousand pounds of tobacco to be paid upon demand  
to wit<sup>h</sup> performance here binds our selves our heirs executors jointly  
or severally at witness our hands and seals the 6<sup>th</sup> August 1672

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above named Stephen Blittman  
shall appear at the next Co<sup>rt</sup> holden for the County of Sommersett there to answer  
what shall be said to his Charge then this obligation to be void otherwise to stand  
in full force which witness our hands and seals the day and year above written

Subscribed Stephen Blittman (Seal)  
Humphrey Davis (Seal)

Humphrey Davis appeared and owned his hand & seals to the obligation  
Blittman Humphrey Davis was forsworn for Stephen Blittman  
to appear at this Co<sup>rt</sup> to answer severall crimes and misde-  
meanors committed by the said Blittman against the  
peace rule and dignity of this Government the said  
Blittman beinge soe to appear the said Davis is  
committed till his Rate satisfied the condition of his bond
