And whereupon the said Robert Cattle for himselfe saith that whereas William Boist Par^t of this County deceased in Januarye the first one thousand six hundred sixty six the sister of the said Boist Jane Delamare was the wife of Thomas Manlove made her residence to the house of the said Robert Cattle and there remained about the space of ten weeks the said Robert Cattle providing for her meate drinke washing and lodging in expectation to have had satisfaction for the same and he saith that the said Robert Cattle hath often demanded the same of her husband Thomas Manlove but he said Thomas hath denied and still doth deny satisfaction for the said Robert Cattle saith he is damaged and hath damaged the value of two hundred and fifty pounds of tobacco and thereupon brings this suit &c

After some dispute by def^t owning that there was nothing paid for the accommodation of his wife at the house of Robert Cattle the Court the def^t Thomas Manlove to pay unto the pl^t Robert Cattle Jun^r one hundred pounds of tobacco in satisfaction ; / ;
