I Thomas Jones doe solemnly declare that my receiver gave
me an amo^t of four hundred twenty and six pounds of
tobacco rec^d from David Williamson for the use of
Beaugamp and my selfe rec^d one h^l more at m^r Brownes
which weighed four hundred and three pounds or there
abouts and thirty three pounds I allowed upon acc^t for
use of the said m^r Beaugamp which said three hundred
amounts to eight hundred sixty and two pounds of
tobacco all rec^d from Thomas Ball for the use of the said

And I doe further sweare that I never received any
more from Tho: Ball for the use of S^r m^r Beaugamp

The C^o sheweth m^r Jones (he being present) the rec^t
given to the def^t subscribed by Tho: Albin & affid^d together
that was not the Albin hand the S^r Jones made answer
he could not well tell until he had compared it with
other writings
The def^t craves answer the C^o upon former consideration
findeth there was no cause of answer and hereupon orders
