And whereupon the said John Tizard for himselfe declares
that he the said Humphrey David in and upon the twentieth
day of July last past in the forty years of the Dominion
of Cecilus Anno Domini 1672 in the dwelling
house of Henry Smith great Brittain in Manourie in
the said County did make an Ipswell and gun and
there forewably and maliciously did strike beats and
evil entreat the said John Tizard and violently

throwing
