Sarah Bass & Malatto by Negro man servant and an  
 English woman servant both belonging to m<sup>r</sup> John White  
 borne in the said John Whites house and by him wholly  
 maintained ever since she was borne and transported  
 out of Virginia into this province as his servant appears  
 in C<sup>o</sup> and depositions her selfe to be now almost eight  
 yeeres of age which is agreeable to the C<sup>o</sup>s judgement  
 her Master John White appears also; Given and confirmed  
 to his said servant one Redd and white pye Cow marked  
 as follows C<sup>o</sup>pt and skin of the left ear and hole on the left  
 ear with one Cow Calf of the same mark with all  
 their female increase from this day upon Condition and  
 provided the aforesaid Sarah Bass continue servant  
 to her said Master John White and his order till she come  
 to the age of one and twenty yeeres which time her  
 C<sup>o</sup> order the said Sarah Bass to serve her said John  
 White or his assigns; the C<sup>o</sup> Judges her to be almost eight  
 yeeres of age; The male increase of the said Cow & C<sup>o</sup>  
 Calf the said John White referreth absolutely to his  
 owne use . . . . .
