

Attorney Saith That he the said John Anderson by Articles  
 made betwene him and the plaintiff bearing date the  
 eight day of Aprill A: D: 1671 and in the xxx<sup>th</sup> year  
 of the Dominion of the R: Roy: Charles the second  
 himselfe to come to the house of the aforesaid Randall  
 Revell at or before the seventeenth day of this instant  
 Aprill there to have with a servant of the aforesaid Revell  
 the quantity of three thousand foute of good planks it being  
 satisfaction for one thousand thirty five pounds of tobacco  
 received of the aforesaid Randall Revell by the aforesaid  
 John Anderson for the performance of whiche he bindeth  
 himselfe his heirs executors administrators in the penal  
 summe of two thousand pound of good tobacco to be paid  
 upon demand after the tenth of October last past or since  
 being had to the said Articles will more plainly appear  
 but he the said Anderson little regarding his promise  
 although made to the loss and damage of the said Revell  
 for the which he praiseth the Court that order may issue out  
 against the said Anderson for the summe of two thousand  
 pound of tobacco and thereupon he bringeth his suite  
 The Articles of Agreement read as followeth:

Articles of Agreement Indented had and made this 17<sup>th</sup>  
 day of May A: D: 1671 betweene John Anderson  
 of the one party of the Province of Maryland and County  
 of Sommersett Sawyer And Mr: Randall of the Province  
 aforesaid Righ Sherriffe of the said County of the other  
 Whithnesseth that he the said John Anderson for and in  
 consideration of the first quantity of one thousand  
 and thirty five pound of merchantable tobacco allowed  
 received
