 Col: Potter did send him over to Peromack with  
 a charge of goods in the year 1669 and further  
 your Deponent saith not  
 Phillip Lambert

Whereas Thomas Davis of Henric County County Taylor standing  
 engaged upon Debt to Phillip Bollakane of the County aforesaid  
 planter in the last summer or quantity of some hundred  
 pounds of tobacco in Cash being for the Consideration of a  
 Jute of Cotton now by the said Thomas Davis of the said Phillip  
 know all men herefore by these presents that Phillip  
 Bollakane aforesaid have constituted ordained appointed  
 And by these presents doe constitute ordaine appoint  
 Authorize my loving friend Alexander King to be  
 my true and Lawfull Attorney for me and in my  
 name (but to the proper use of the said Alexander King)  
 to after Demand recover and receive all and every the  
 said Summe of tobacco aforesaid of the said Thomas  
 Davis Granting unto my said Attorney full power and  
 and Lawfull
