 not Dispose of any of the said Combes or their inheritance until he
 cometh to the age before recited without my Consent, And that
 if they Inheritance to manij it shall be at my pleasure to Convert
 them to other use for the benefitt of my said Sonne without
 Disturbance or Molestacion from any person or persons what
 soever, These Combes with their female Inheritance Edward
 Prince his Statour doe freely and absolutely give unto my
 Sonne James and to his Heires perpetuall and assignes of my
 said Sonne James forever peaceable and quietly to enioye
 as his owne proper goods at the time above specified for Confi-
 rmacion and full assurance of the truth above written of the said
 Edward Prince doe unto these presents set my hand and fix
